Leadership and Management

Priority 1: To improve leadership and management at all levels to secure the rapid improvements needed.

- 1.1 Ensure staff have the subject knowledge and skills they need to implement the curriculum effectively for all pupils, including those with SEND and disadvantaged.
- 1.2 Ensure leaders have an accurate view of what the school needs to do to improve and acts incisively to bring around rapid change.
- 1.3 Ensure leadership of Early Years is effective in addressing areas of weakness at pace.

Personal Development, Behaviour and Attitudes

Priority 3: To ensure that all pupils consistently behave as well as they should.

- 3.1 Ensure that leaders and all staff share the same high expectations so that pupils behave as they should and participate in their learning
- 3.2 Ensure pupils have sufficient knowledge of protected characteristics, world faiths and fundamental British Values so that they are well prepared for life in modern Britain.
- 3.3 Ensure attendance is improved for all pupils



Quality of Education – Phonics and Reading

Priority 4: To continue to improve the quality and consistency of teaching for all pupils in reading and phonics.

- 4.1 Ensure the quality of teaching in phonics is consistent throughout the Early Years and Key Stage One
- 4.2 Develop the quality of teaching in Reading across school.
- 4.3 Develop provision for children identified as being in the lowest 20%

Quality of Education

Priority 2: To rapidly secure improvements in the quality of teaching across the school so that lessons consistently closely match the needs of pupils including those with SEND and disadvantaged.

- 2.1 Ensure a systematic approach to assessment is in place and that teachers use it effectively to identify and address gaps in pupils learning.
- 2.2 Ensure the curriculum is developed so that pupils develop an understanding of equality, world faiths and British values.
- 2.3 Continue to develop teachers' understanding and effective use of pedagogical approaches to ensure that teaching and learning is improved.
- 2.4 Ensure that in all subjects the curriculum helps all pupils with those with SEND secure important knowledge and build on what they've learnt before.
